MSC is pleased to announce its new feeder connection between Oulu and Antwerp

MSC will introduce its new service from and to Oulu in week 34/35.

The service is based on Merilinja's two 700 teus vessels calling Oulu once a week connecting with MSC's worldwide services in MSC Home Terminal in Antwerp. The call in Kokkola will resume to a fixed weekly call at the same time.
